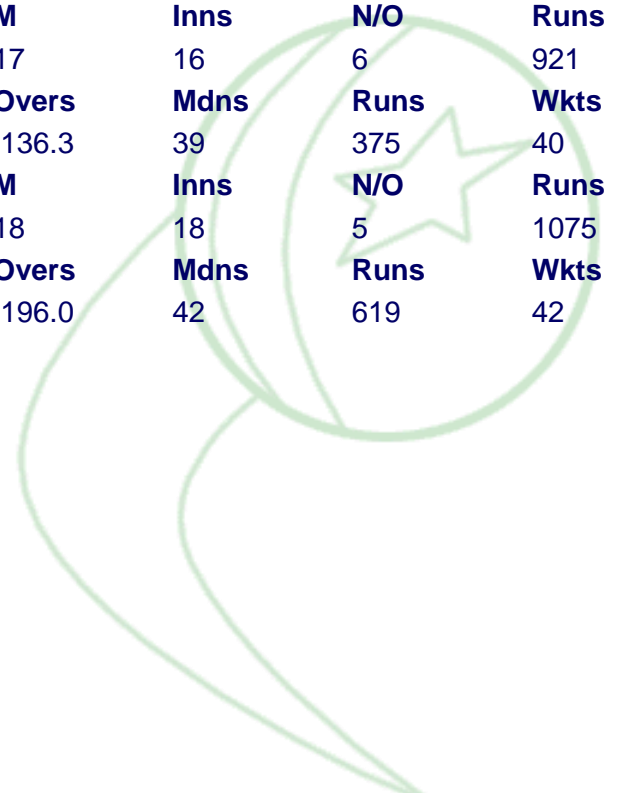

Changes to the Constitution



Changes to the Constitution (1)

- In rule 13 a) 'Player Eligibility' add after '.....No player may be registered to play for more than one league club at any one time' (except in the Regional Divisions where an application is made to the registration officer for temporary registration of a player with another club for a particular match where the registration officers decision shall be final-and that temporary registration shall only apply to the match in question and would have to be re-applied for, for any subsequent match)

- Please also note that any reference in the Handbook to whether DBS clearance shall required for a club member shall mean a cricket specific DBS clearance. Clubs are therefore advised to ask all members who require DBS clearance to check to see that their clearance is cricket specific otherwise new clearance will need to be obtained

Changes to 2018 Match Rules for Premier Division and Championship to be ratified under rule 11d



Rule 15: Play Offs

If a result is not achieved on either day the result will be determined by a Bowl Out. Such Bowl Out shall be undertaken in accordance with the rules set out in match rule 13 of the Readers 20/20 Competition Playing Conditions (which also provide for a result by coin toss if a bowl out is not possible).

Rule 16: Promotion & Relegation

The side finishing 9th in the Premier Division and the side finishing 2nd in the Championship will play a Play-Off under the 50 over match rules, using balls approved for use in the Premier Division. The winner will play in the Premier League and the loser will play in the Championship in the following season. The match will be played on the Saturday of Week 19 at the ground of the side finishing 2nd in the Championship unless agreed otherwise by the two clubs. In the event of adverse weather the reserve date for this match is the following Saturday, i.e. seven days later.

Match Rule For 'Timed' Matches In Weeks 6 To 14

Rule 3: Bowling Restrictions

In an uninterrupted match no bowler shall be permitted to bowl more than the greater of 20 overs or one-third (rounded down) of the overs available at the start of the innings. If the number of overs available is reduced as a result of any interruptions in the match the maximum shall be one-third (rounded down) of the reduced number of overs. A bowler may exceed the limit solely as a result of such a recalculation of overs due following an interruption in play.

Side winning toss and batting first or losing toss and batting second

Win – 30 points

Tie – 15 points

Winning Draw – 6 points, Losing Draw – 2 points

The Winning and Losing draw is calculated on run-rate for the innings, based on legitimate balls received. Run rate shall be calculated to three decimal points. In the event that the two sides have identical run-rates the side losing the fewest wickets shall be deemed to have the higher run rate. If still equal then each side shall receive 4 points.

Bonus points:

Batting – 2 points for reaching 125, 175, 225, 275, 300

Bowling – 1 point for taking 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 wickets

Side winning the toss and fielding first

Win – 30 points

Tie – 15 points

Winning Draw – 6 points, Losing Draw – 0 points

Batting – 1 point for reaching 125, 175, 225, 275, 300

Match Rules For The 50 Overs Competition (Matches In Weeks 1 To 5 & 15 To 18)



Match Rule 1: Coloured Clothing

All sides are required to wear coloured clothing in this playing format. Batsmen and the wicket-keeper are recommended and encouraged to wear coloured pads.

Duckworth-Lewis-Stern Procedure

Rule 1: The Professional Edition of Duckworth-Lewis-Stern (DLS), requiring the use of a working laptop computer and a printer, will be used to calculate the Target Score. In the event of failure of all of the available computer(s) for any reason, then the Standard Edition will be used to calculate the Target Score.

Changes to Match Rules for 2019

NB Under rule 11d of the Constitution, clubs will be voting to introduce changes to Match Rules on an experimental basis for one year. Such changes will then be put to next year's AGM for permanent adoption.

1. All matches in divisions 7a to 10 b shall be of 90 overs duration.

rule 14 shall be deleted and replaced with :-

In Divisions 1 to 6b inclusive Law 22 shall apply with the following addition:

- a) Umpires are instructed to apply a strict and consistent interpretation in regard to this Law in order to prevent negative bowling wide of the wicket.*
- b) A leg side wide shall be called if, irrespective of where the ball pitches, it passes outside of the line of the striker standing in his normal guard position and the leg stump. A wide shall not be called if the striker moves towards the off-side and the ball would have struck any part of his person had he not moved.*
- c) A ball that passes between the Striker and the leg stump shall not be judged a wide.*
- d) An additional crease marking shall be made 17 inches inside and parallel with each return crease, joining the Popping and Bowling creases. Please note that the crease is the inside edges of both these new markings and the Return Crease markings. An off-side wide shall be called if, in the umpire's opinion, the delivery has passed between the 17 inch line and the Return crease and the Striker has not brought it within reach of a scoring stroke.*

(this part of the rules is the same as for the 2018 season in so far as it relates to divisions 1 to 6b) inclusive but the layout has been changed. So to be clear there is no proposed change to the wide rule in those divisions) What follows below is the new proposed wording.

e) In Divisions 7a and below the umpires and captains shall ensure that consistency is achieved across both innings for determining what constitutes a wide delivery. The Division of the match should be taken into consideration when deciding what should constitute a wide delivery

(f) Except in the final over of each innings (as defined in (g) below), for every Wide signalled by the umpire two runs shall be added to the Batting side's total and there shall be no additional delivery in the over. In the final over of the innings one run shall be added to the Batting side's total for each wide and that delivery shall not count in the over.

(g) The final over of the innings shall normally be the 45th over in divisions 7a) to 10b) or the 40th in the regional divisions. Where the innings has been reduced by interruptions or delays to fewer than 45 or 40 overs the final over shall be the last scheduled over of the innings.

Rule 15: Promotion & Relegation

Under match rule 15 on page 8 in the rules handbook the words :-

'The winners of Match 1 and Match 2 will play a Final at the ground of the highest placed side (based on League position) unless the League determines that a neutral venue shall be used. In the event of adverse weather a reserve date will be arranged by the League Executive Committee.'

Shall be replaced by the words:-

'The winners of Match 1 and Match 2 will play a Final on a neutral ground, which will be determined by the League. In the event of adverse weather a reserve date will be arranged by the League Executive Committee.'

Rule 3.1: Bowling Restrictions

In match rule 3.1 on page 11 of the rules handbook the maximum number of overs a bowler shall be allowed to bowl shall be reduced to **18**

Rule 1: Hours of Play (Timed)

In '**Hours of Play**' on page 10 of the rules handbook ,clause 1.1, shall be replaced with the following:-

1.1 Play will commence at 11.00am.

1.2 The Lunch Interval will be 30 minutes commencing at 1.00pm, unless changed under the provisions of Law 11.

1.3 There will be an interval of 10 minutes' duration between innings.

1.4 The Tea Interval will be 20 minutes, commencing at the later of 4.20pm or when a maximum of 20 overs remain to be bowled before the Last Hour, unless changed under the provisions of Law 11.

1.5 The Home club will provide a meal during the first 30 minute interval and refreshments during the second 20 minute interval.

1.6 The umpires shall signal the Last Hour at the later of 5.30pm or when 17 overs remain to be bowled in the match. The Last Hour shall be a minimum of 60 minutes from its commencement and a minimum of 17 overs shall be bowled unless play is interrupted, in which event rule 2.8(b) shall apply.

1.7 Unless a result is achieved earlier the game shall finish at the later of 6.30pm or when the Last Hour has been completed.

Umpire Marking

Although not a rule change please note that ,as mentioned in the pre-amble ,we are changing the penalties for not reporting umpires' marks in the Premier ,Championship and divisions 1,2 a) and 2 b) so that under 'Umpire Marking' at the bottom of page 18 of the main handbook from ...'Please note' to.....'the second Friday after the match' will be deleted and replaced by :-

'Please note that the date and time of each report is automatically recorded. For divisions Premier, Championship ,1 ,2 a) and 2 b) for each failure to report by the Friday deadline up to the 30 June, 2 points will be deducted from the team's points total for the match in question and for each failure after 30 June, the points deduction shall increase to 5 points for each failure'

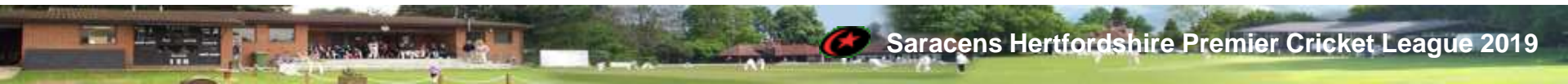
