Under 13 Player Consent Form 2022

Prior to being eligible to play in Open Age cricket, Youth players details MUST be registered as detailed below. Also, parents/ guardians and clubs must adhere to following conditions.

- An under 13s Cricket Age is the player's age as at midnight on **31st August 2021**
- The Parent/Guardian of an Under 13 must give written permission to their club for their child to be eligible to be registered to play in the Saracens Hertfordshire Premier Cricket League
- The players Club Safeguarding Officer, prior to registering the player to play in SHPCL, must have received the completed form.
- The players Club's Safeguarding Officer shall keep a copy of the written permission in a safe place.
- The completed form must be made available, upon request to SHPCL Registration Officer or his representative.

- **To verify that playing in Open Age cricket would enhance the player's development, this form must be signed by the under 13 players Club ECB CA level two Coach.**

- Parents/ Guardians should note that the players date of birth is listed on SHPCL website, although only age group is visible to the public.

- SHPCL Committee may, in certain circumstances, request that a club provides further evidence of a player's written permission or age group.
- The club must adhere to ECB Directives for juniors in open age cricket.
- **An under 13 is not eligible to participate in SHPCL Premier and Championship divisions**
