

Notes on completion of Team Sheet:

- Age for 'Under 18' column is based on the day of the match
- Age for 'Under 13' and 'Age Group' columns is determined as at midnight on 31 August of the preceding year
- Age Group column is to identify all players U19 and younger for fast bowling and fielding directives

Each player's name is to be entered onto this Team Sheet and must match the name registered with the League and shown in the scorebook. **The names must also be confirmed via the Herts League app by 9pm on the evening of the match. Penalty for missing this deadline is a deduction of 5 points.** Teams can be entered ahead of the match, as soon as selected, but any late changes need to be recorded before the 9pm deadline on the match day.

The following is to be completed by the person responsible for the team and provided to the umpires or, in the absence of non-playing umpires, to the opposing captain before the toss takes place.

Results and Team Reporting by Captains

Use the Herts Cricket app (for iOS and Android) to report match results and record players' names. Results can also reported via the League website. All results, **including cancelled and abandoned games**, and teams, are to be reported **by 9.00pm on the day of the match**.

It is the responsibility of all **home XI** captains to report the result by the required deadline and **both teams** should enter names of their own players. The home XI is the side that appears first in the fixture list in the League Handbook, regardless of where the game is played. If the result and/or teams are not reported before the 9pm deadline on the day of the match, the relevant teams **will be penalised 5 points**.

Any fines for non-provision of a scorer or where bonus points should be deducted for taking wickets outside the time limits can be reported on the website or reported to the Results Secretary, Richard Mason, via email to results@hertsleague.co.uk (or via text to 07491 834644 if email is not possible) within 48 hours of the match taking place.

Facilities & Umpire Reporting by Captains (divisions 1 - 6B)

Facilities marks must be entered via the Herts Cricket app or website by the **visiting captains** for all matches in Divisions 1-6B. **This includes cancelled or abandoned matches**. Facilities reporting **deadline is 9pm on the following Wednesday**, or face a **5 points deduction**. For umpires reports (divs 1, 2A, 2B only) the **deadline is 11pm on the following Friday, or incur a deduction of 2 points (5 points after 30 June)**.
